

# Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE) Indicator Progress: Diagnoses

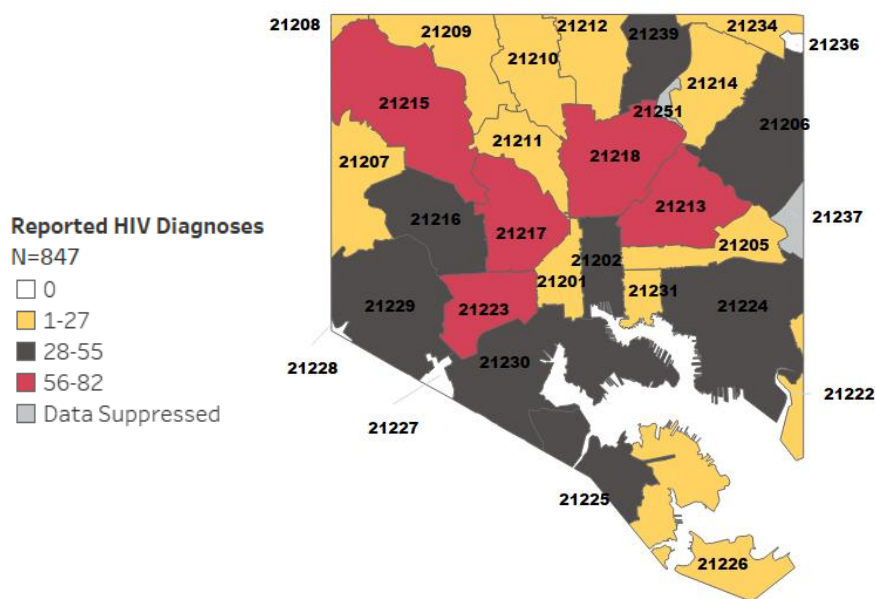
## Baltimore City

### Diagnoses Indicator



As one of the six indicators of EHE progress, the goal of the diagnoses indicator is to **decrease** the number of confirmed HIV diagnoses from the 2017 baseline.

### Reported HIV Diagnoses by ZIP Code, 2017-2020

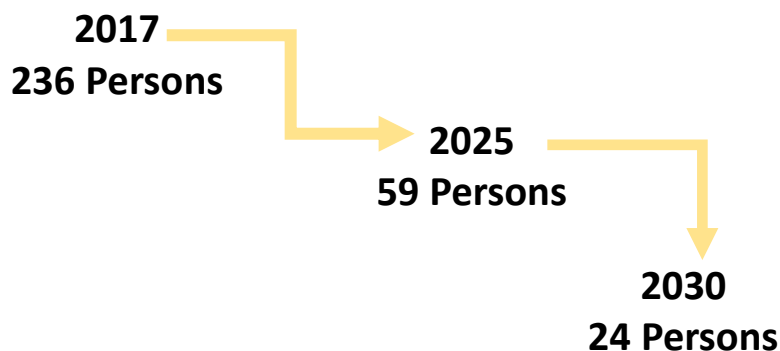


In 2020, there were 177 newly reported HIV diagnoses in Baltimore City.

At the end of 2019, **1 in 9** people living with HIV in Baltimore City were unaware of their status.



The EHE goal is to decrease HIV diagnoses by **75%** by 2025 and **90%** by 2030.



Multiple imputation was used to estimate and adjust for missing exposure category. Data represents adults and adolescents (ages 13+) only. Data source: Maryland Enhanced HIV/AIDS Reporting System (eHARS). Data Reported through June 30, 2021. Data for 2020 should be interpreted with caution due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on access to HIV testing and care-related services.
