

Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE) Indicator Progress: Diagnoses

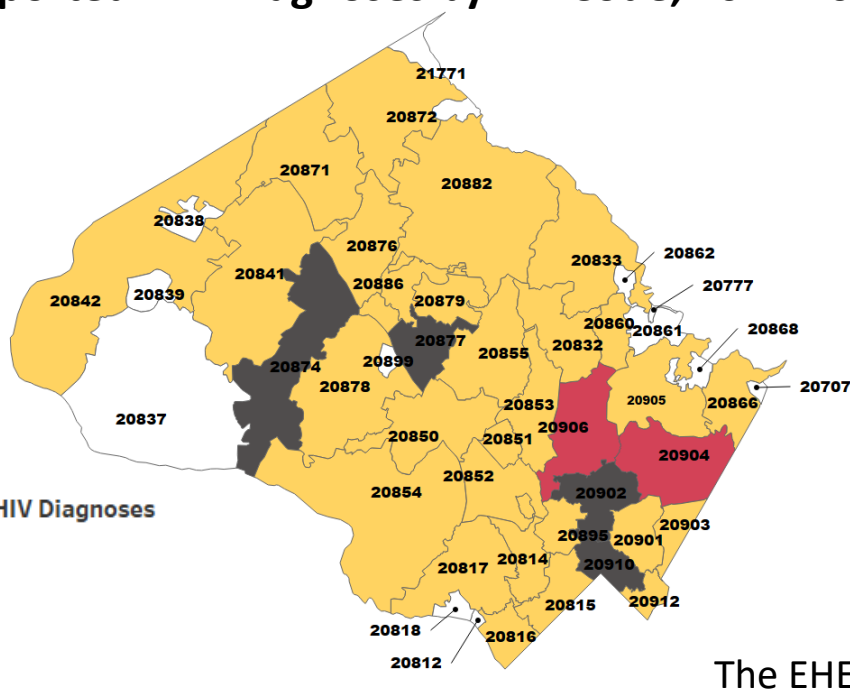

Diagnoses Indicator



As one of the six indicators of EHE progress, the goal of the diagnoses indicator is to **decrease** the number of confirmed HIV diagnoses from the 2017 baseline.

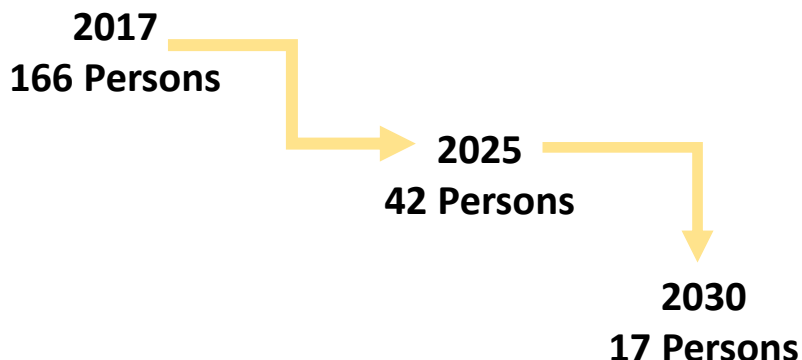
Reported HIV Diagnoses by ZIP Code, 2017-2020



In 2020, there were 83 newly reported HIV diagnoses in Montgomery County.

The EHE goal is to decrease HIV diagnoses by **75%** by 2025 and **90%** by 2030.

At the end of 2019, **1 in 9** people living with HIV in Montgomery County were unaware of their status.



Multiple imputation was used to estimate and adjust for missing exposure category. Data represents adults and adolescents (ages 13+) only. Data source: Maryland Enhanced HIV/AIDS Reporting System (eHARS). Data Reported through June 30, 2021. Data for 2020 should be interpreted with caution due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on access to HIV testing and care-related services.
